Current Rehearsal Guidelines and Protocols

- Singers are placed in “ platoons ” of 9 or fewer singers.
- Rehearsals include 30 minutes of singing.
- Rehearsals are outdoors or in the large indoor space of the Sanctuary.
- Singers are physically distanced by at least 6 feet.
- Singers, director, and accompanist wear masks at all times.
- Pews and surfaces are sprayed and sterilized between platoons.
- Air is circulated between platoons for 15 minutes.
- Singers carry rehearsal materials with them (water, music, pencils, etc.)

Back in Season 2, GCA performed a concert in Forsyth for the Forsythia Festival in the First Baptist Church of Forsyth. This performance has sweet memories for those who sang there, as the dome ceiling of the church provided a “cathedral-like” resonance that was fun to sing with and created a beautiful choral sound. The concert itself was a “greatest hits” program, pulling repertoire from our relatively brief performance history.

We will be recording our fall concert, “To The Nines” in this beautiful space with its ringing acoustic. Each platoon will

record their two songs over two evenings in Forsyth. The finished product will be released on Thursday, October 15.

Kitty Grubbs accompanies the platoons on piano with her signature expressiveness and flair. A few additional instrumentalists will appear to provide added color, including percussionist Marcus Reddick and flutist Jayne Widener.
