

Program Notes

On March 9, 2020, we had our last "regular" Griffin Choral Arts rehearsal before suspending our activities for the pandemic. Exactly one year later, on March 9, 2021, we honor and celebrate frontline hospital workers from our local Wellstar Spalding Regional Hospital. As our world was slowing down to an eventual halt, THEIR pandemic journey was just starting to take off. Since the beginning of the health crisis, they have worked additional hours and shifts on top of their already intense schedules. They have adjusted their job responsibilities and have taken on new roles and learned new skills. They have had to handle unthinkable pressure, and they have had to provide care under the most trying of situations. They are heroes.

This day, we provide a musical tribute to their dedication and resilience. We sing words of faith, love, and hope. We stand in recognition of their outstanding efforts in service to our community.

In addition to our musical tribute, we share written expressions of love and support, from our Griffin Choral Arts family and from area school children. And, finally, we share baskets of snacks to say "thank you" and to make those long shifts a little sweeter and more bearable.

The Music of "With These Hands"

"With These Hands" was to be our May 2020 concert project. The theme leaned into hands lifted in praise, hands folded in prayer, and hands reaching out to help others. We commissioned a new choral composition that used a text written by a local 5th grader. That premiere composition and much of that concert repertoire is on hold until we can get back to regular concerts. We had hoped that by March 2021 we would be able to try again. But, we had to again adjust our plans and postpone the original concert concept.

But the "With These Hands" theme turned out to be perfect for this tribute event. Bobby Wheaton's revised concert artwork features medically gloved hands forming the shape of a heart, aptly symbolizing the love and care provided by healthcare workers over the past year.



The hands/heart image is further embodied in the newly written text for "Serenade of Gratitude" (words by long time GCA singer and program-note writer Bill Pasch). The song begins with these words:

"Loving hands, selfless hearts..."

This final selection of tonight's program uses the partner-song melody from the well loved GCA Christmas concert closer "Peace, Peace" with a new text.

All of the music on tonight's program is sung *a cappella* (unaccompanied).

The program begins with a simple Taizé chorus, *Ubi caritas*. Beginning with a solo child's voice and building into the full choir, the Latin text is repeated many times in variations.

As the choir sings *Ubi caritas*, they assume an ancient prayer posture known as Orans. The palms-up gesture represents a position for releasing (supplications, burdens) and for receiving (blessings, gifts).

The spiritual *Hold On!* is a work song with a theme of resilience and determination. The verses call forward biblical images including the Old Testament story of Noah as well as the admonition from Jesus in Luke 9:62: "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."

Maurice Duruflé composed his motet setting of *The Lord's Prayer* (*Notre Pere*) in 1978. Decicated to his wife, Marie-Madeleine, it was his last published composition. Normally performed in French, we will sing an English edition tonight.

In March 2010, Griffin Choral Arts performed Karl Jenkins' The Armed Man in a collaboration with the Griffin Ballet Theatre. One of the most memorable concerts in our history, it's hard to believe that was over a decade ago in Season 3. The work (which has considerable energy and orchestral color throughout) concludes with a simple chorale: *God shall wipe away all tears*. The first part of the text is directly from Revelation 21:4. The second half of the chorale is a flowing, therapeutic repetition of the phrase "Praise the Lord."

The *Serenade of Gratitude* concludes the program, perhaps conguring up the emotions of the annual Christmas concert closer. Instead of a prayer for peace on earth, the new text is an expression of heart-felt thanks for outsanding service provided to our community by the hospital staff and frontline healthcare workers.
